- Windows XP Professional Service Pack 2 (English) is the required Operating system; XP Home will not be accepted as it is not suitable for use on a large network, such as at UCD Quinn School of Business.
- If purchasing a non preferred laptop to use in Quinn School you should ensure that Office 2003 Professional, MS FrontPage 2003 Professional and Windows XP Professional are included in the purchase price.
- The RAM requirement of 256 MB is required for quality performance using MS Windows XP Professional and Office 2003 Professional.
- Antivirus software is a mandatory requirement for any laptop wishing to connect to the Quinn School network. SophosTM Anti virus solution is available to UCD students via a campus license agreement. Students should note that SophosTM Antivirus solution is owned by UCD Computing Services and as a result will need to be removed upon completion of your degree.
