#### Introduction

This small collection of photographs was deposited in the Franciscan Library Killiney in 1984 by Mr Brian Barrett, a journalist with Independent Newspapers. The cohesive figure through all the photographs is Eamon de Valera with whom Mr Barrett came into frequent contact through political reporting for the *Irish Independent* and with whom he seems to have established a more cordial relationship than one assumes is usual between a politician and a political reporter. While Mr Barrett features in most of the photographs himself, there are other autographed prints which must have been given to him by Mr de Valera. Most of the eight photographs actually date from the period after Mr de Valera's election to the Presidency.

The presence of the de Valera Papers in the FLK was, it is safe to assume, the incentive for Mr Barrett to deposit the photographs there. They were transferred to University College Dublin Archives Department in July 1997 with the other non-Franciscan private paper collections in the FLK. photographs have simply been described The in chronological order. Most had been framed and displayed and some, the colour prints particularly, had deteriorated. Much of the descriptive information has been taken from captions attached to the photographs by Mr Barrett.
