
Applying to UCD College of Arts & Humanities Summer Study Abroad Programme


2 week programme (CF30) and 4 week programme (CF31) Study Abroad Programme

Students applying to come to UCD College of Arts & Humanities on Study Abroad for the Irish Studies 2 week summer programme (**CF30**) and the 4 week programme (**CF31**) should apply using the UCD application system by following the steps below:

- 1. Go to <u>UCD Course Catalogue</u>
- 2. On the page, type the Major code into the Search Box eg **CF30/CF31** and click to search



3. Keep scrolling down until you find Study Abroad Arts & Humanities **CF30** or **CF31** on the list and then click on the yellow Apply button next to the course. This will redirect to a new login page (below) and prompt the student to create their account.



- 4. Once the student has created their account, they will receive an email from UCD IT Services with their login credentials. To continue with their application, they should click on the 'Continue' hyperlink embedded in the email.
- 5. Students will be asked to login using the credentials recently created, and will land directly on the application form for the **Study Abroad Arts & Humanities Summer programme CF30/CF31** programme they have chosen.
