Benefits of Being a Career Ambassador

Being a Career Ambassador is not just a job. This is a developmental programme designed to develop and enhance your skills via a range of opportunities.

- Enhance the UCD student experience and have a positive impact on prospective students' experiences at UCD
- Enhance your professional network within and outside of UCD
- Increase your employability by developing your self-confidence, self-efficacy and self-esteem
- This is a paid position: €12.70 per hour
- Career Ambassador work can be included as one of the 2 activities needed to complete the UCD Advantage Award, which will appear on your diploma supplement

Role & Responsibilities

- Promote, attend, and assist with careers events, including organisation and execution as necessary; to include events such as graduate recruitment and internship fairs, open days, alumni panels, or employer events.
- Support and promote the UCD Advantage Award and other Career Network initiatives.
- Create social media content, including video content for Facebook, Twitter, Instagram, LinkedIn and YouTube
- Run competitions and giveaways on behalf of the UCD Careers Network
- Create visual designs that aid the promotion of any of the above mentioned (e.g. using Canva)
