The International Pre-Master's Pathway Programmes offer students the best way to prepare for their world class UCD master's degree through a combination of academic, language, cultural and study skills modules.

PROGRAMME SUMMARY

The International Pre-Master's Pathway Programmes offer the flexibility of a one trimester (Certificate) programme starting in January or a two trimester programme (Diploma) beginning in September. Students will attend English for Academic Purposes classes and modules relevant to their academic subject area. Students will also have the opportunity to take thesis preparation, cultural, and creative thinking modules while acclimatising to life in UCD before commencing their Master's studies.

International Pre-Master's students must meet the academic entry requirements of their chosen Master's. International Pre-Master's students achieving the progression requirements will automatically receive a full offer for their Master's. Progression requirements for different UCD Master's programmes may vary.
