## Policy Toolkit: Approval Bodies

University Policies are formally approved by the relevant governing body - Governing Authority (GA), University Management Team (UMT) and Academic Council (AC) or Academic Council Executive Committee (ACEC). These approve the proposals for policy development and review and the final policy or amendments to policy.

Most University Policies align broadly with the remit of the Approval Bodies. The table below makes a rough categorisation of policies and suggests approval pathways for different policy areas. The categorisation is indicative, not exhaustive. If in doubt about the appropriate formal consultation and approval, contact the <u>University Secretariat</u>.
