Tionól Description

Tionól Gaeilge UCD is aimed at adults in Ireland and abroad who are interested in the Irish language and in Irish culture. It will also suit students, both in Ireland and abroad, who are studying Irish as a subject or undertaking an Irish Studies degree.

Language classes will be held each day, Monday to Friday, from 9.30am until 1.00pm. These classes will be offered at five levels and the emphasis will be on developing the participants' spoken language skills.

Lectures will take place in the afternoon, Monday to Thursday, in which the focus will be on various aspects of the Irish language and culture – folklore, for example, placenames, literature and the singing tradition. School participants can choose to attend an Irish language version or an English language version of each lecture; the speaker will deliver the talk in one language and then, after a short break, he/she will give the same talk in the other language.

Cultural events will be held each evening as well.

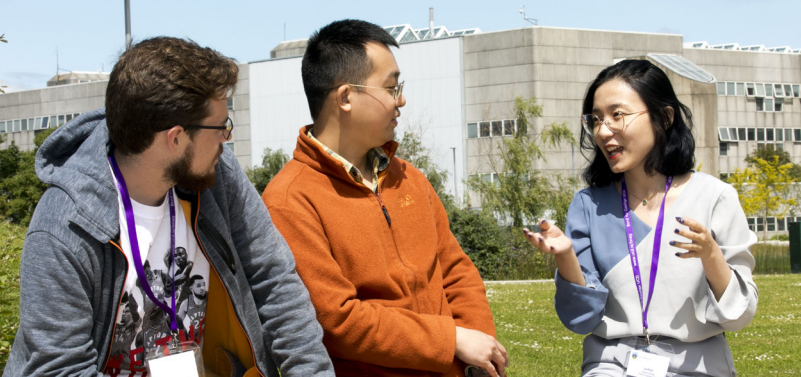

Ionad Domhanda UCD don Teanga agus don Chultúr is ea Gaeltacht UCD. Déanann an t-ionad freastal orthu siúd ar fad ar mian leo teagmháil a bheith acu leis an nGaeilge. Déantar é seo trí réimse tionscadal a bhunú agus a riar a chuireann an teanga chun cinn go gníomhach ar bhonn laethúil. I measc na dtionscadal sin, tá cúrsaí teanga, scéim cónaithe Gaeilge, imeachtaí cultúrtha agus seirbhísí aistriúcháin.
