Beidh ranganna teanga ar siúl gach lá, Luan go hAoine, ó 9.30am go 1.00pm. Déanfar na ranganna seo a thairiscint ag cúig leibhéal éagsúla agus is ar an teanga labhartha is mó a bheidh an bhéim.

Beidh léachtáí ar siúl tar éis lóin, Luan go Céadaoin, ina ndíreofar ar ghnéithe éagsúla den Ghaeilge agus den chultúr Gaelach – an béaloides, cuir i gcás, logainmneacha na tíre, an litríocht agus an amhránaíocht. Beidh deis ag na rannpháirtithe freastal ar leagan Gaeilge nó ar leagan Béarla de gach léacht; tabharfaidh an léachtóir an chaint i dteanga amháin ar dtús, ansin, tar éis sosa, sa teanga eile.

School Description

Tionól Gaeilge UCD is aimed at adults in Ireland and abroad who are interested in the Irish language and in Irish culture. It will also suit students, both in Ireland and abroad, who are studying Irish as a subject or undertaking an Irish Studies degree.

Language classes will be held each day, Monday to Friday, from 9.30am until 1.00pm. These classes will be offered at five levels and the emphasis will be on developing the participants' spoken language skills.

Lectures will take place in the afternoon, Monday to Wednesday, in which the focus will be on various aspects of the Irish language and culture – folklore, for example, placenames, literature and the singing tradition. School participants can choose to attend an Irish language version or an English language version of each lecture; the speaker will deliver the talk in one language and then, after a short break, he/she will give the same talk in the other language.

Maidir le Gaeltacht UCD

Ionad Domhanda UCD don Teanga agus don Chultúr is ea Gaeltacht UCD. Déanann an t-ionad freastal orthu siúd ar fad ar mian leo teagmháil a bheith acu leis an nGaeilge. Déantar é seo trí réimse tionscadal a bhunú agus a riarr a chuireann an teanga chun cinn go gníomhach ar bhonn laethúil. I measc na dtionscadal sin, tá cursaí teanga, scéim chónaithe Ghaeilge agus clár cultúrtha. Tacaíonn an ionad leis an Ollscoil, forálacha Acht na dTeangacha Oifigiúla (Leasú) 2021, a chur i bhfeidhm. Cuireann an t-ionad fáilte faoi leith roimh mhic léinn agus baill foirne idirnáisiúnta, alumni agus lucht an diaspora.

Is é an Coláiste Ollscoile, Baile Átha Cliath, Ollscoil Dhomhanda na hÉireann agus áirítear é i measc an 1% de na hinstiuídí is fearr ar domhan.
