Grazing plan:

The AFC was recorded at 772kg on the 10th of March, with growth rates of 11kg. To manage the grass supply and quality effectively, grass walks are being conducted weekly. Growth rate has fallen over the last week, as a result the cows will be offered grass and silage until the growth rate is able to meet the herd's demand. Cows will be grazing by night. From the 14th of March, the diet will consist of a grass allocation of 8kg DM, 6kg DM silage, and 10kg of concentrates. 2kg of the concentrate allocation will be fed with the silage allocation. Weather and ground conditions are being closely monitored. Between the 10th and 13th of March, soil temperature measurements were taken, with the average recorded at 9.3°C. Between the 4th and 10th of March 6.5mm of rain fell on the platform.

Calving:

Calving started on the 15th of January and there is currently 45/56 of the cows calved as of the 10th of March.



Comments:

45 cows were BCS on the 12th of March. 4% scored 2.5, 40% scored 2.75, 33% scored 3.0, 15% scored 3.25 and 6% scored 3.5.
