



Intravenous Cannulation and Contrast Agent Administration CPD

Overview

This event:

- Equips participants with practical ability the undertaking of intravenous contrast agent administration.
- Provides theoretical training for radiographers and radiation therapist undertaking intravenous administration in imaging departments
- Provides background knowledge of contrast agents and pharmacological agents used in imaging departments.

Event Structure

- Lectures will be a mix of online pre-recorded lectures, online live lectures and reading materials.
- Candidates will have to successfully complete a short MCQ based on the online content.
- Candidates will attend a compulsory intravenous cannulation clinical skills laboratory on cannulation training arms with UCD lecturers who have experience in intravenous cannulation.
- Candidates are required to engage with online record of clinical practice after the clinical skills lab, where they will log observed, assisted and unassisted intravenous cannulation attempts while in their respective departments.
- On completion of Record of Clinical Practice, successful candidates will receive a Certificate of Completion, stating competence in Intravenous Cannulation and Contrast agent Administration.

Entry Requirements

- The course is open to radiographers and radiation therapists.
- Candidates are required to arrange for a suitably qualified supervisor who will be required to oversee their clinical experience and complete competency sign off in the clinical department.
- All candidates must have access to a broadband internet connection and a working headset to engage with online material and live online lectures.
- Candidates must be available to attend online live lectures and clinical skills laboratory
