Hepatitis B

- Hepatitis B is a liver disease which can lead to serious, lifelong illness
- Vaccination is the most effective strategy for prevention of infection (WHO, 2016)
- May already be vaccinated through HSE immunisation programmes
- Will need to provide evidence of BCG status to Occupational Health Department
- If needed: Programme of Hepatitis B Vaccination
 - **3 doses = 1st dose** soon after occupational health appointment **2nd dose** approx. one month later **3rd dose** approx. 5-6 months after the first dose
- Post Hepatitis B Titres to check response levels
- Blood test to establish presence or absence of immunity

Healthcare screening 8 vaccination Programme

Blood test will establish if you have immunity for the following:

- Measles
- Mumps
- Rubella
- Tuberculosis (TB)
- Varicella (Chickenpox)
- Pertussis (Whooping Cough)

If not immune, Occupational Health Department will provide vaccinations



Healthcare screening & vaccination Programme



MRSA will be screened in stage 2 & stage 3 of the programme prior to attending practice placements



Influenza vaccination is highly recommended & is provided through a GP or pharmacy surgery



COVID-19 vaccination is highly recommended & is provided by the National Immunisation Office



COVID-19 vaccination may be required by some Healthcare Service Providers









