Registration Key Dates

- Module Registration will follow the same pattern and start time groups as last year with minor changes.
- Registration starts Wednesday, 14 August.
- BSc Sustainability will register with Arts/Social Sciences/Business/Law.
- Elective Allocation Monday, 2 September.
- Registration will close on Friday, 20 September.
- All dates published on <u>Student Key Dates</u>.



Key Dates Stage 1

- Stage 1 Students will register to modules on 5 and 6 September and will start term on 9 September with continuing students.
- Students that did not progress from stage 1 will register with incoming cohort.
- Grad entry Med/Vet/Radiography will register on 5/6 September.
- Programmes with significant choice at Stage 1 will be prioritised to register on 5 September due to the tight timeline.



Academic Regulations – Key Changes

- Progression Students may now progress carrying maximum 10 credits from any preceding stage – students are being advanced on this basis at present.
- Workload a governing board may allow a student to take a resit beyond the 40 credit per trimester limit if academically appropriate.

- •All Colleges/School offices have a "referred to Student Desk" button, which we encourage people to use if they ask a student to contact us.



STUDENT CHECK-IN

- Continuing, International (both UG and PG) and PhD students can check in from August 29th 2024.
- Students do not have to arrive on this date exactly, but can check-in any time from the morning of August 29th
- Some students can avail of an early check-in.
 Namely the Campus Assistants (RAs) and some
 Smurfit students that have an earlier orientation



CAO BOOKINGS

- In Order for CAO students to receive room offers, they must first be registered and be given their UCD Connect login details. They log in with these details to our housing portal to pay their deposit and accept the room offer.
- Once CAO students are given a Registered or Active status, this will appear on our booking system, and we can proceed with room offers
- CAO Students will have 48-72 hours to pay their booking deposit to accept the room



CAO BOOKINGS

- Following from CAO offers on August 28th, we anticipate that we can begin sending offers of accommodation on August 29th through to September 1st for 1st round CAO students, and continuing with the other rounds from then on.
- CAO students can check in from September 3rd, in time for the beginning of their orientation.
- Room offers will continue as further rounds of CAO offers go out



CAMPUS ASSISTANTS

- Our new Campus Assistants will be on-hand to help students settle in and answer any questions they have.
- This team is made up of current students, many of whom have lived in Res before
- There will also be refreshments provided for parents and can help deliver lugagge for students

- UCD ResLife will be running an extensive events programme during the start of the academic term.
- Led by our new team of Campus Assistants we aim to make UCD the most welcoming place it can be.
