Learners who are granted credit or exemption	Yes	RPL data summary C/E	Annually	Infohub report will only capture the numbers for RPL applications approved (as it is only when application approved that DA task is raised in IH). Declined applications can be captured from the online RPL application form but not all Schools/Colleges use this form. (report available from this workflow in IH)
Learners who gain programme entry (including cohorts of students)	Yes	Salesforce CRM (2025 entry and subsequent AYs)	Annually	Data is high level - only RPL - needs to be further categorised as RPL formal, Experiential or combination.
Learners who gain advance entry to a programme (i.e. beyond level 1)	Yes	Salesforce CRM (2025 entry and subsequent AYs)?	Annually	DA graded credit task is created for internal transfers which result in advanced entry to another programme Admissions maintain an excel spreadsheet for external transfers into stage 2 or later as no non-graded task raised for external transfer applicant. On request from Admissions the Student Records team apply the non graded credit directly to the applicants record.

Basic criteria for deciding if data should be collected and reported as RPL?

Mapping process of prior learning to programme entry requirements and/or programme module learning outcomes is required/performed
Requires an academic assessment and judgement
