### What is the Joanna Briggs Institute?

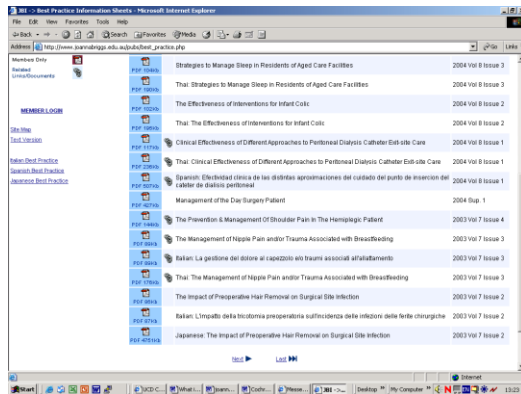

From 'Evidence Libraries' you can link to Systematic Reviews, Review Protocols, Best Practice Information Sheets, Technical Reports and Executive Summaries

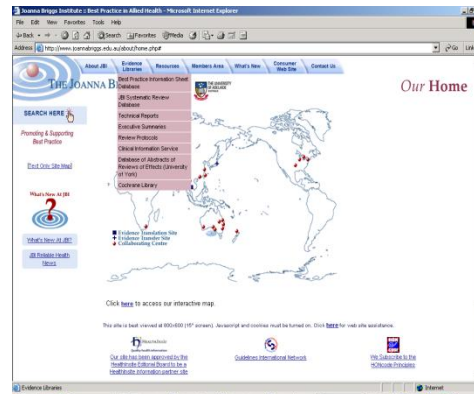
### Finding Material

The most effective way to find material is to browse through each Evidence Library, using the 'First' & 'Last' navigation buttons. Full text access is available for Review Protocols, Best Practice Information Sheets, Technical Reports and Executive Summaries.



### Systematic Reviews

Systematic Reviews address issues in healthcare by bringing together scientific studies relating to a specific topic. You can browse through the JBI Database of Systematic Reviews using the 'first' and 'last' navigation buttons



Access to Systematic Reviews is available from UCD through Blackwell-Synergy. Go to the Nursing Studies Subject Portal - 'List of Databases' - Blackwell-Synergy. Use the 'Advanced Search' option to search for the Title and Author of the Review
