Position Summary:

The School of Veterinary Medicine, University College Dublin seeks to appoint a temporary Lecturer Assistant Professor in Large Animal Surgery. The duration of the appointment is for 36 months.

The candidate will join a team of 3 other Large Animal Surgeons (1 full-time and 2 part-time) and 2 Doctoral Students (ECVS residents) within the Section of Equine Clinical Studies, Diagnostic Imaging and Anaesthesia and the UCD Veterinary Hospital. The successful candidate will work as part of a large multidisciplinary team in the large animal /equine clinic.

The successful candidate's role will involve primarily clinical service teaching and administration, with opportunities and support to pursue research. Lecture delivery and on-clinic group and one-to-one teaching of undergraduate and graduate veterinary practitioners (MVB) and veterinary nursing (BSc) forms a key component of the role.

Principal Duties and Responsibilities:

- Acting as a Senior Clinician, independently providing a referral surgical service.
- Providing high quality, evidence-based management of a variety of elective and emergency surgical cases, including advanced imaging and equine dental treatment.
- Participating in the hospital's rota for out-of-hours work (at present on 1 in 3 rota).
- Supervision of Doctoral students/ECVS resident training.
- Active participation in undergraduate and post graduate teaching of veterinary medicine and veterinary nursing students.
- The appointee will be expected to contribute/develop a research programme leading to grant applications and publications in refereed journals. Research collaboration with other scientists is encouraged.
- The appointee will contribute as a member of the Section and School committees to the successful functioning of the organisation.
- Participation in Continuing Professional Development activities.
- To undertake any other reasonable duties as required by their line management.
